

WORKING TOGETHER TO INCREASE UPTAKE OF COVID-19 AND SEASONAL INFLUENZA VACCINATIONS

Dear colleague(s),

The potential co-circulation of COVID-19 and seasonal influenza will put vulnerable population groups at an increased risk of severe illness and death this autumn and winter. In addition to the individual impacts, this will also likely increase the pressure on hospitals and health-care workers, already exhausted from almost 3 years on the front lines of the pandemic. The European Commission, European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control and WHO/Europe have joined forces to raise awareness of the need to protect the most vulnerable this autumn and winter period.

As both administrators and recipients of COVID-19 and influenza vaccines, this webinar aims to give healthcare professionals the opportunity to discuss the latest epidemiological and scientific developments, as well as the available support for awareness-raising and communication campaigns that can help increase the uptake of vaccines and protect the most vulnerable.

To help countries prepare their response to a likely increase of COVID-19 and influenza in the coming months, the Commission published a Communication on preparing for autumn and winter 2022-2023 and WHO/Europe has issued strategy recommendations to protect the most vulnerable. Together, the documents call on countries across the European region to relaunch mitigation efforts and be ready to respond to an increased burden on their healthcare systems.
